ADAM - Sehy - Born - March 25 - 1848
Died - (He was a Tailor)

Vassellor, Germany
Theinphatz

He came to U.S. at age about 18 - from Germany - at that time it was Prussia and had a King - His parents - were Farmers - & all were French - But the Germans had invaded & took over the land - (But they were French) So the King denounced Adam - and he had to return his part of the Estate to the King - When he sailed for America I had (but now my son has) the document the King signed him release to become a citizen of U.S. It and his passport was sent to me from a Cousin of mine (now deceased) L. Brown from Appleton Wis - Her father was my father's Bro - & she (the brother died early in life) and when he married my father Edward Henry Sehy - went there & gave her in marriage - She died in 1992 - from Cancer - I tried to get in touch with her Bro. in Law - But no response so far - We didn't know our Father's side very well till quite late in life - I wrote to a few Cousins in Ill -

But all are gone now I'm sure. My father H.E. Sehy went to College to be a Priest - after 2 or 3 yrs - he felt he wanted to have a family - & he & his older Priest or Bishop decided he should return home & explain it to parents' family He did & they wouldn't accept it so they denounced him & he moved away - They were all Catholics - He decided to attend different churches - met my mother - he was a very intelligent man spoke German, Italian & French & U.S - He was a Publisher & Printer - very handsome & full of humor

She came to visit in Breckenridge Tex & decided to stay
But returned to Albert - But left baby with my mother -

back - Albert didn't - She was pregnant & stayed from then on

with us - She gave birth to Gertrude Ellen Quant there *

Hazel Louise - 1st daughter born to Ed & Gertrude Seby -
She was premature weighed only 2 lbs - they kept her in a
small basket - kept bricks in oven to change often to keep
a certain temp - my Dad (we called papa) - told us his
Wedding ring would slip over her hand & go to the elbow -
she was dark skinned - BIG eyes & hair - chunky and
could repair a car - build a wagon - she build a chair
for my daughter Judy at age 1 - very sturdy & cute -
she cared for people & stayed in their houses - for employment
Gertrude your Grandmother stayed with me for her first
year of school - Rural - her teacher was my husband's
cousin's wife - lived close by - then they went to N.C. Mo
with my mother & was with them till Gertrude was probably 8 or so
Went to Calif & stayed with my Sister Helen Hamilton &
then home to KC - Hazel married John Yates -
date? -

They had 3 girls - 1/2 Sisters to your grandmother Gertrude
I Wanda Joine - Born 1932? Littleton Colo - She was also a
premature - was to be born in April but got here in Feb -
Hazel had an accident fell or slipped in a hole hanging
clothes outside - almost lost her leg - was hospitalized
